Science	<p>Biology – <u>The Human Body</u></p>	<p>Physics –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Energy, Forces & the Structure of matter.</u> • Pupils will explore the different types of energy and how they can be transferred. • Pupils will remember that energy cannot be created or destroyed but can be stored in many different ways,. • A braking force will cause an energy transfer that makes a vehicle slow down and heats the brakes. The braking distance of a vehicle depends on many different things, such as the speed of the vehicle • The energy resources available to use may be divided into renewable and non-renewable. • Energy can also be released from atoms, which contain smaller particles such as neutrons and protons in the nucleus, 	<p>Chemistry – <u>Elements compounds & mixtures</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils will learn about the three states of matter; solid, liquid and gas. They will then learn how matter is composed of tiny particles called atoms. • They will look at these elements in the periodic table. When two or more elements combine we call them a mixture. • Pupils will explore how we can separate mixture by processes such as filtration. 	<p>Biology - <u>Environment, evolution & inheritance</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils will learn that life on Earth is dependent on photosynthesis, • how living organisms interact with one another and their environment in different ways and how some human behaviours may have beneficial or detrimental effects on natural populations and the environment. • Pupils will have practical investigations to explore natural adaptations, temperature and photosynthesis. • Pupils will also learn about how life on Earth has developed over time, we will look at Darwin’s theory of evolution and artificial selection. 	<p>Physics- <u>Electricity, magnetism & waves</u></p>
