The Priory and Garth Schools are settings for students who have wide ranging special educational needs. The Priory School caters for 11 to 16 year olds with moderate learning difficulties. The Garth School caters for 2 to 19 year olds with severe and profound and multiple learning difficulties. As an Apprentice Teaching Assistant, you will have a varied and rewarding role working with students across the schools as a whole. You will primarily be supporting staff in providing the students with creative, aspirational, relevant and engaging learning experiences as well as a variety of different interventions that take place within the classroom. A highly specialised and extensive training programme will be facilitated by schools in addition to that provided through Boston College.

Your duties will include, but will not be limited to;

- Supporting the class teacher in the classroom to ensure high quality learning takes place
- Help with the delivery a range of different intervention sessions to individuals and small groups of students as part of their daily learning experience
- Lead play activities during the lunchtime
- Take an active role in toileting and changing our students as and when appropriate
- Undertaking lunch time and break time duties
- Completing any paperwork relevant to the role
- Any other duties as reasonably requested
